

1 May - 1 Oct. 1924: Eagle in Laurel-wreath, Printed typography by the Stae Graphic Institution, Warsaw (a modified E.Trojanowski design), on thin and, later (in 1925), on medium paper. Perf. 10 to 13½ and compounds.

2.VII.24: Post card, probably the 1922-1925 third card listed in the Polish Specialist Cat. Vol.1., p.210, sent from Warszawa to Kraków with "Porto" comment. Stamps used 1, 2, and a pair of 3gr (total 9gr) stamps of the first post-inflation issue.



14.I.25: Very thin private (Back) card, sent from Cracow to Leipzig (Germany) with 3gr orange, 5gr sage-green, and 10gr blue-green stamps.



5.VI.24: Cover sent from Warsaw to Cracow, with 15 gr scarlet (first post-inflation issue).



1925: Registered Airmail Cover of 1925 (!) sent from Warszawa to Jerusalem, with one 10gr and a pair of 50gr (total zł 1.10) on the reverse, plus cash postage of 30gr on the front of the cover. The cover has been opened somewhat roughly, but it is complete.
